## **Executive summary**

The first quarterly meeting of the Citizens Health Reference Group took place at County Hall on Monday 3 June 2024. Following the receipt of a number of apologies, only three members attended the session in person with one more attending virtually via MS Teams. The Group currently consists of 14 members, however a recruitment has just concluded which means following an induction period over the next two months, numbers will be significantly bolstered in the near future.

Members heard from chief nursing officer Sarah O'Brien who gave a presentation on her role and the ICB, as well as an update on some of the issues and challenges currently being faced. This was followed by a positive discussion on a number of issues, including the importance of primary care, challenges in social care and the role of patient participation groups.

While the Group is still developing, members have supported the ongoing work on a strategy around urgent and emergency care transformation and have reflected positive discussions with the ICB regarding this piece of work.
