Thank you for your request dated 5 June 2024.

We can confirm that the ICB does hold the information you requested.

Please find our response to your questions below:

1. How many individuals do the local authority/NHS commission with Adults complex care using Live-in care at home (24-hour care with the carer staying in the property)

Due to the system used, we cannot differentiate between Live-in care and care at home.

2. How many providers do the local authority/NHS work with for Adult complex care at home and how many of those providers have clinical leads?

Currently we commission with 54 complex care providers who can all clinical task.

3. What is the commissioned rate for Adult complex care at home for 2023?

The system we utilise (Sproc) is a competitive system in which providers place offers on packages of care, so there is not an agreed commissioned rate.

4. Is there a separate framework for complex care at home and if so is it open?

Providers who register onto the Sproc system, enrol under service categories (complex care). The ICB only currently enrol providers in the Lancashire and South Cumbria area. This is an open framework and the exception is Central Lancashire and East Lancashire where we are no longer enrolling providers due to the volume of providers we currently commission with in these areas.

5. What is the name of the commissioner for complex care for adults?
