We can confirm that the ICB does hold the information you requested.

Q1	<p>Your Question:</p> <p>I enclose the FOI reply's from the ICB on the Lancashire CCG deficit, it seems like a game to you on the wording, going back to the first FOI you inform me that all CCG will receive the resources to deliver this break even deficit so can you provide the figures that each CCG received BEFORE the 30 June 20</p>
	<p><b>Our Response:</b></p> <p><b>A section 22 exemption has been applied as this information is intended for future publication.</b></p> <p><b>As figures for individual CCGs are being requested, this will form part of the statutory annual accounts which are mandatory to publish. Q1 2022/23 Annual Report and Accounts will include CCG accounts up to June 2022 and they will be published within the year, once a full independent audit (statutory) and sign off by the ICB has taken place.</b></p> <p><b>The 2021/22 Annual Report and Accounts have been published and include the accounts up to March 2022:</b></p> <p><b><a href="https://www.icb.nhs.uk/annual-reports">Lancashire and South Cumbria Integrated Care Board :: CCG Annual Reports (icb.nhs.uk)</a></b></p>

You will note that we have applied an exemption to question 1. This is explained below:
