| Q2 | <p>Your Question:</p> <p>I would like to know the background of these patients if the information exists.</p> <hr/> <p><b>Our Response:</b></p> <p><b>Please note, under Section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 - Information can be withheld if it relates to information which constitutes personal data.</b></p> <p><b>The first condition is that the disclosure of the information to a member of the public otherwise than under this Act—</b></p> <p><b>a) Would contravene any of the data protection principles.</b></p> <p><b>In this instance we believe that it would likely breach the first Data Protection Principle, therefore we are restricting the requested information (the background of patients) to prevent the possibility it could potentially identify an individual or inadvertently identify any patients.</b></p> |
